Non-Discussion Poster Presentation Guidelines

38th Annual Meeting of the International Continence Society, 20th-24th October 2008, Cairo

Dear Colleague

Some practical points regarding your **Non-Discussion Poster Presentation** at this year's ICS Meeting:

Poster Size:

- Portrait orientation
- Maximum 90cm wide x 150cm high

Heading and Text:

- Heading should be 80-100 point.
- No smaller than 24 point (approximately 5mm) – large enough to be read at a viewing distance of approximately 1 metre.

General Advice:

- Posters should communicate your message as simply as possible – do not allow it to become clogged with too much detail.
- Use less words and use figures, photographs and diagrams to break up the density of the text.
- Seek advice from colleagues, medical or graphic artists.

Location:

- Plan to have your posters hung for the duration of the Scientific Programme from Wednesday 22nd October until Friday 24th October.
- Your poster location will be indicated by an assigned number. This information will be included in the Final Programme, which will be given to you when you register at the Meeting venue.
- Please put up your poster on Wednesday 22nd October any time from 0730 until 1100. Please note that the poster boards will not be set up prior to this time.
- Double sided tape and technical equipment will be available for the mounting of posters. Staff will also be available to assist you.
- Please remove your poster on Friday 24th October between 1230 and 1330.

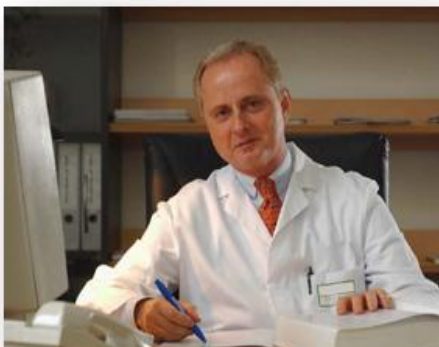
Attendance at Non-discussion Posters:
