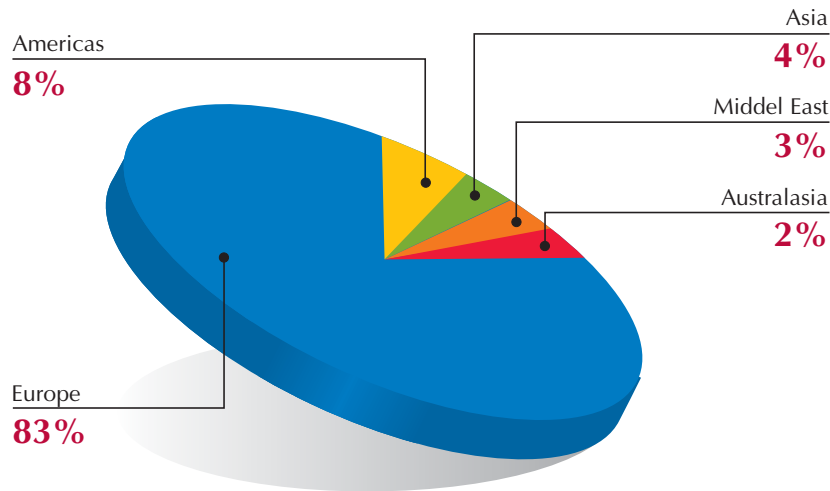

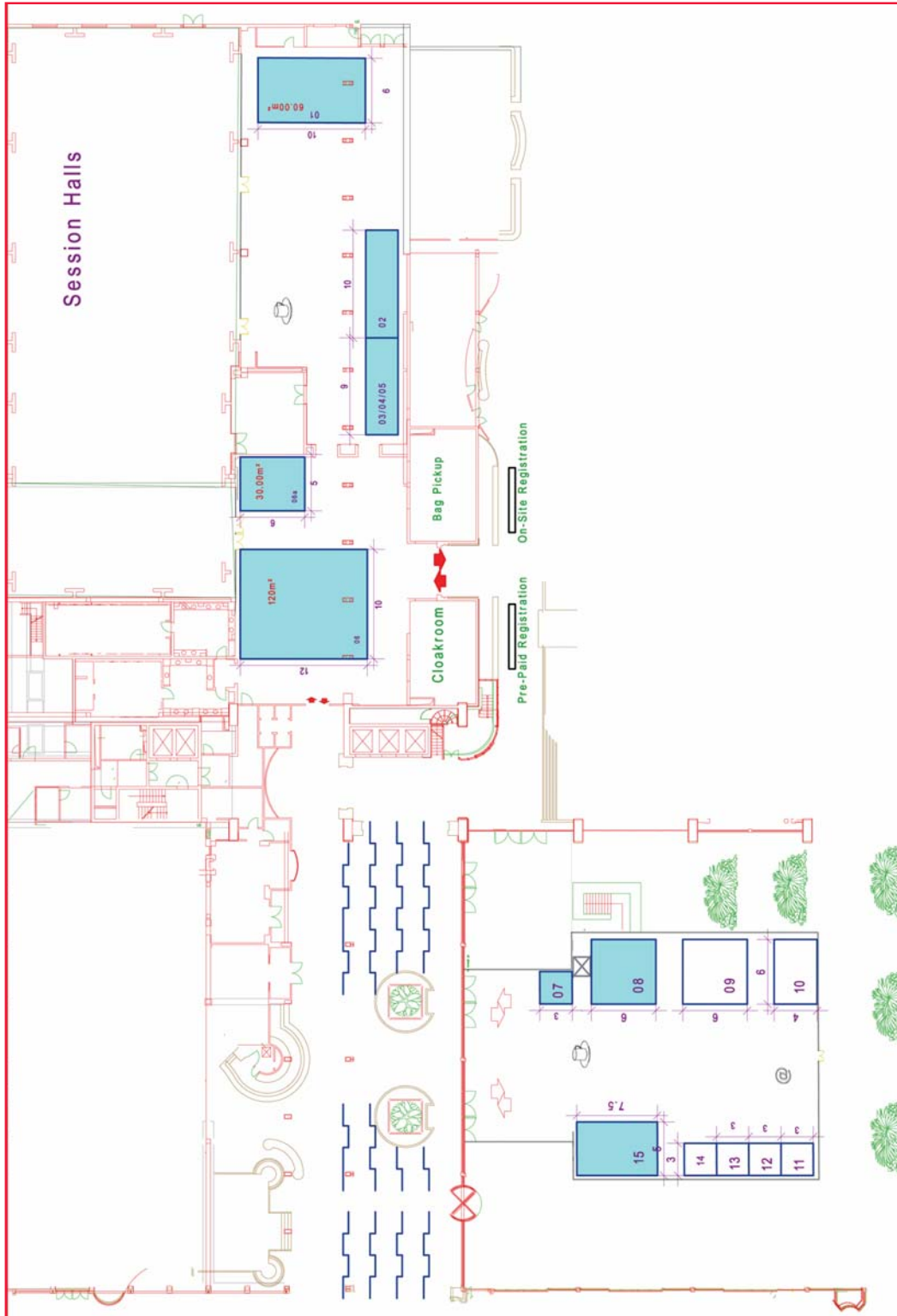

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms are the contractual agreement between the Organizer and the Exhibiting Firm (Exhibitor/s).

Application to Participate
