

Bio of Prof. Troels S. Jensen, MD, DMSc

Troels S. Jensen, MD, DMSc, is a consultant in neurology and Professor of Experimental and Clinical Pain Research, leading the Danish Pain Research Center at Aarhus University, Denmark.

Dr. Jensen obtained his doctor of medical sciences degree from the University of Aarhus for work in part carried out at the Mayo Clinic, Rochester, Minnesota. He completed his postgraduate clinical fellowship at the Hôpital de la Salpêtrière in Paris, France, and his residency in neurology, neurosurgery, and neurophysiology at university hospitals in Aarhus and Copenhagen. Dr. Jensen has held research fellowships and guest professorships in other countries, including the US and Germany.

Dr. Jensen has authored more than 300 scientific papers on various neurological and neurobiological topics, and has received awards for his pain research. He was section editor for the journal *Pain*. He serves on the editorial boards of other journals, and is a reviewer for a number of pain and neurology journals and grant committees. Dr. Jensen has been member of several committees particularly within International Association for the Study of Pain (IASP) and is currently the President of the.

In 2006 Dr. Jensen was Knighted by Her Royal Highness the Queen of Denmark.
