

Prof. Dr. med. Koichi Noguchi

Prof. Dr. Med. Koichi Noguchi is head and chair of Department of Anatomy and Neuroscience, Hyogo College of Medicine, Nishinomiya, Hyogo, Japan. He received his medical and PhD degrees from Osaka University Medical School, and completed postgraduate research in NIH, USA (1989-1991, Prof. Ron Dubner).



From 2005 to 2006, he served as President of the Japanese Association for the Study of Pain (JASP). Now he has served as a councilor of the International Association of the Study of Pain (IASP, 2002-2008).

His main research interest is the Neurobiology of pain. He has examined the molecular mechanisms of chronic/persistent pain such as inflammatory or neuropathic pain using neuroanatomical, neurochemical, electrophysiological, molecular biological, and behavioral approaches. He has published over one hundred fifty of journal articles, reviews, and book chapters, and has lectures at conferences and symposia internationally.
